

Turning off FreePBX Error Handling

Some people may wish to turn off FreePBX's error logging capability and use the native error handler. You may do this by adding `$bootstrap_settings['freepbx_error_handler']` before requiring `bootstrap.php` in `/etc/freepbx.conf`. You can see an example below:

```
<?php
$samp_conf['AMPDBUSER'] = 'freepbxuser';
$samp_conf['AMPDBPASS'] = 'changeme';
$samp_conf['AMPDBHOST'] = 'localhost';
$samp_conf['AMPDBNAME'] = 'asterisk';
$samp_conf['AMPDBENGINE'] = 'mysql';
$samp_conf['datasource'] = ''; //for sqlite3

//Turn off FreePBX Error Handling
$bootstrap_settings['freepbx_error_handler'] = false;

require_once('/var/www/html/admin/bootstrap.php');
```

Please note that if you have a module that is using bootstrap, you can do this before bootstrapping as show below:

```
//Turn off FreePBX Error Handling
$bootstrap_settings['freepbx_error_handler'] = false;

if (!@include_once(getenv('FREEPBX_CONF') ? getenv('FREEPBX_CONF') : '/etc
/freepbx.conf')) {
    include_once('/etc/asterisk/freepbx.conf');
}
```
