The Voicemail Reports module (also known as "VM Reports") provides an easy way for system administrators and managers to review all users' voicemail settings in one place, as well as listen to all voicemails residing on the system.

## Greetings & Settings

Allows you to quickly view the voicemail greetings and settings for each user, see who needs to record greetings, and see who is set up to receive voicemail to e-mail.
